## Guidelines for Visiting Parties.

Above all we would like you to enjoy your visit to Lakeside and Haverthwaite Railway, please follow these simple guidelines to ensure you have a safe and enjoyable day. We have done our best to ensure the safety of all visitors and staff to the railway but please remember that this is a working railway with many visitors. Vehicles will be coming in or out of the car park as well as buses turning round. Steam trains often move much quieter than people expect although sometimes there are sudden emissions of steam or noise so pay careful attention when you are on the platform. For the well-being of your group, please discuss basic personal safety and these guidelines with them, prior to your visit.

As well as the chance to enjoy a scenic journey up the Leven Valley pulled by an historic steam engine, you will also have the opportunity to look round our engine shed and restoration projects. Please remember that staff might be working on these so do not touch or climb on the machinery. As well as being dirty or oily they may also be hot or have sharp edges.

- 1) Please be careful when crossing the car park and watch out for moving vehicles.
- 2) Please keep back from the platform edge especially when the train is approaching or departing.
- 3) Do NOT try to board or disembark from the train when it is moving.
- 4) Do not run or fool around, especially in the car park or on the platform.
- 5) Only cross the line by means of the footbridge
- 6) Parents and guardians please ensure your children behave in a considerate and responsible way.
- 7) You are welcome to look at the exhibits in the car park and engine shed but please do not climb on them, or tamper with any machinery.
- 8) Please keep dogs under control (on a leash).
- 9) Please put litter in the bins provided.
- 10) Obey the instructions of staff at all time.

Please report any damage or anything you have reason to believe could later result in damage or affect the health and safety of visitors or staff, to a member or staff.

- In the event of **FIRE** please make your way via the marked exits out to the assembly point in the main car park. Staff will assist you.
